Diploma in Reflexology

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

RFX 101 Reflexology Theory

The course introduces the basics and benefits of acupressure and reflexology, showing the student, step-by-step, how to nurture emotional and physical well being in those seeking help and relief through reflexology. Modules concentrate on how to target specific body parts in order to address select ailments and improve emotional as well as physical well being.
